## APPLICATION PROCESS F-1 VISA (International Students)

### STEP 1

- Complete de application for admission form
  - Send us a copy of your passport
  - Pay \$100 application for admission fee (bank transfer, debit/credit or wester union deposit)
  - Complete de affidavit of financial support form (\$6000 – F-1 student) (\$500 additional F-2)
    - Send us a copy of the affidavit, and attach the copies of bank statements (3-6 last months of it)
  - Pay \$75-100 for courier DHL certified (cost depends of the country)
  - All documents have to be sent at [admission@americanone-esl.com](mailto:admission@americanone-esl.com) (PDF files)
- Once you complete STEP 1. We will send you a package including your I-20 and other instructions.
  - This package will arrive to your home country in between 3-5 business days.

### STEP 2

- Make sure all the information on your I-20 is correct
- Sign your I-20 and date it
- Activate your I-20 by paying your SEVIS fee I-901 form (<https://www.fmjfee.com/#>)
- Print the receipt confirmation for your visa interview

### STEP 3

- Complete the DS-160 form (<https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/>)
- Print the confirmation for your visa interview
- Pay your visa interview fees. You will find more details on the web of your home country embassy

- Get the interview receipts and confirmation

### STEP 4

- BE READY AND TAKE SUPPPORT DOCUMENTS FOR YOUR INTERVIEW. Take with you the following:
  - Original passport
  - Original I-20 signed and dated
  - Original Affidavit of Financial support and Bank statements
  - SEVIS receipt-confirmation form I-901
  - Confirmation of the DS-160
  - Receipt confirmation of your appointment for your interview
- Other suggested documents and your academic preparation, such as:
- Transcripts, diplomas, degrees, or certificates from schools you attended; and
  - Standardized test scores required by your U.S. school (if needed)
  - Your intent to depart the United States upon completion of the course of study; and  
How you will pay all educational, living and travel costs.
